

Georgia Association of Persons in Supported Employment (GAPSE) is offering monetary assistance to aid an individual or individuals to gain employment in a job that would not otherwise be possible. Any recipient must have a documented and significant disability. Up to \$5000 will be awarded to an individual or individuals that make the best case indicating that use of the money will result in or assist in employment.

The applicant (whether the individual who will be the supported employee or a job coach/employment specialist or other advocate) must be a legal Georgia resident, a GAPSE member, and the potential employee must have a documented significant disability. (Please attach to your request the documents proving disability and residency.)
